Although somewhat dated the Trustees have to make grants which

- Further Education in the basic principles of Christian morality
- Promote and maintain the spiritual teaching of the Church of England and the doctrines and observances that serve to manifest such teaching
- Promote a higher standard of moral life in the individual, the family and the community
- Assists and Guides those persons by reason of difficulty in their personal relationships or otherwise are in need of material assistance or moral guidance

In fulfilling their role Trustees like to make a significant contribution to a specific project or item of equipment.

**Trustees usually make smaller grants but will in exceptional circumstances make grants of over £1,000**

A letter of application, with any relevant accompanying material, is needed.

The letter should be based on facts and figures. Where is the work situated? How many people will benefit? Who will be the beneficiaries? What will the project do? Will the Trust's grant kick-start the work? And when will it start? When will it end? How will you know whether it's been a success?

**And most importantly let us know how what level of grant you need from the Trustees.**

**Applications must come from within Wakefield Diocese, and be supported by a parish.**

**No grants are given to individuals.**
